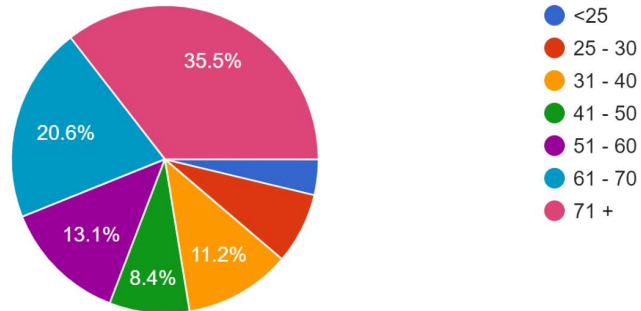

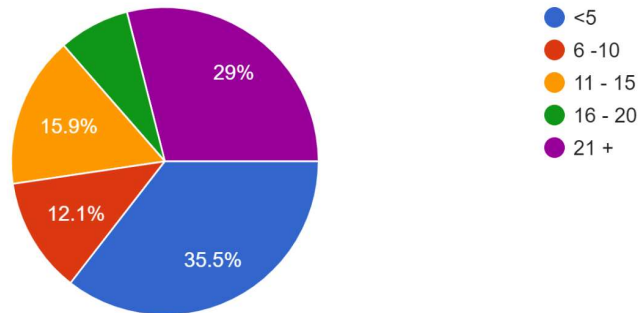
I am in the age group: (in years)

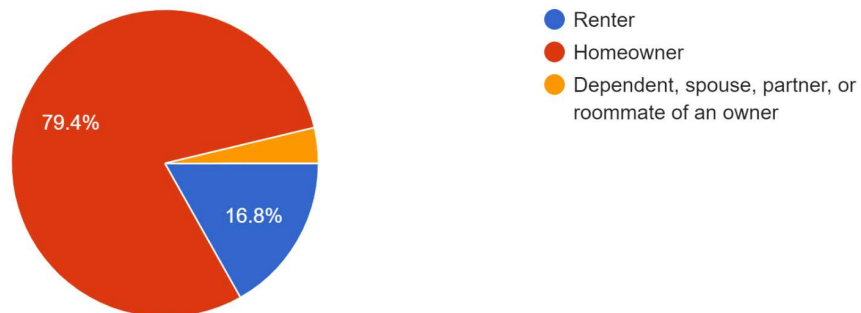
I have lived at the Brentwood: (in years)

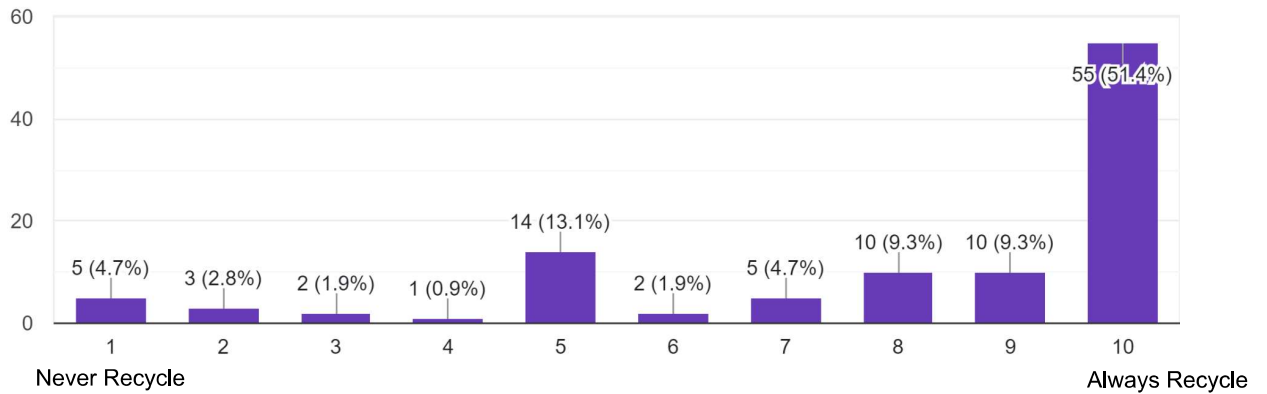

# Recycling is very important to Brentwood Residents

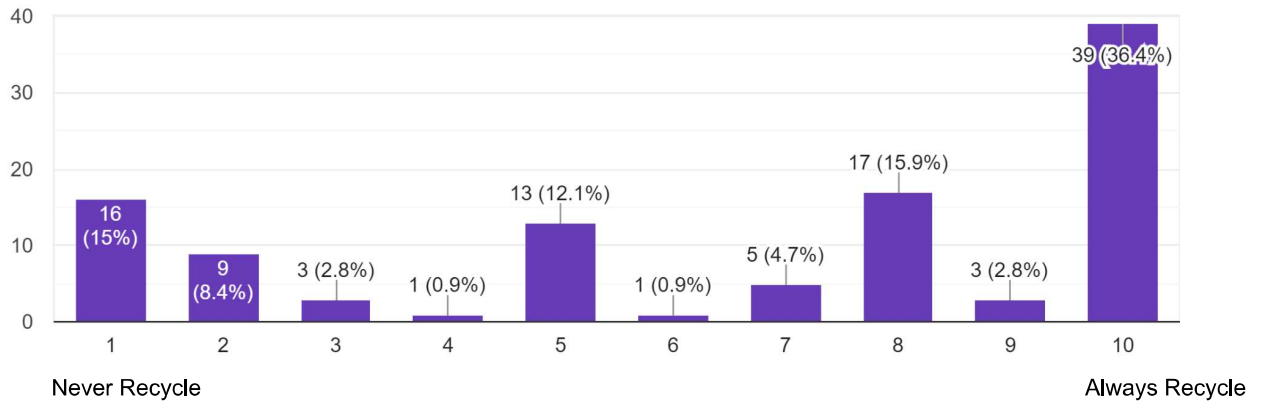
How do you feel about recycling?

The Association pays approximately \$1000 per month in fees for over-stuffing and contamination. How important is recycling to you at the Brentwood (taking into account the listed expense).

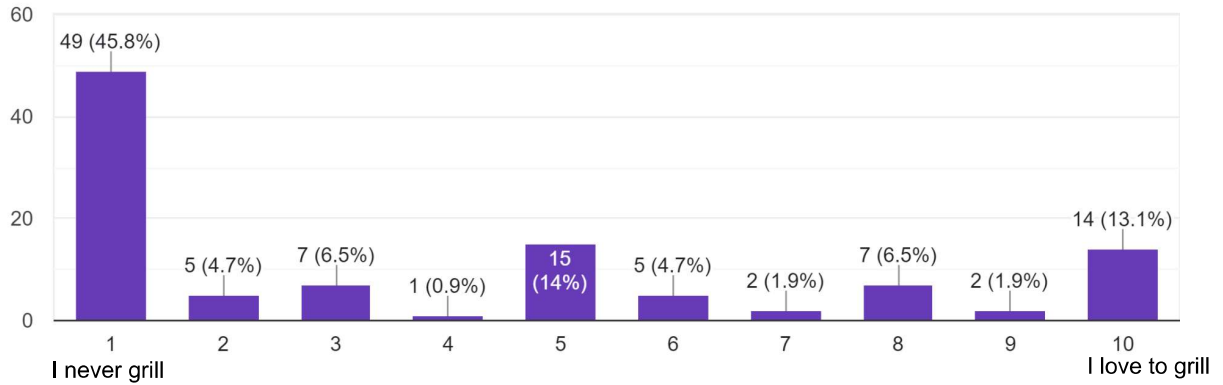

Should we convert one of Brentwood's courtyards into a community grilling area for all residents to use?

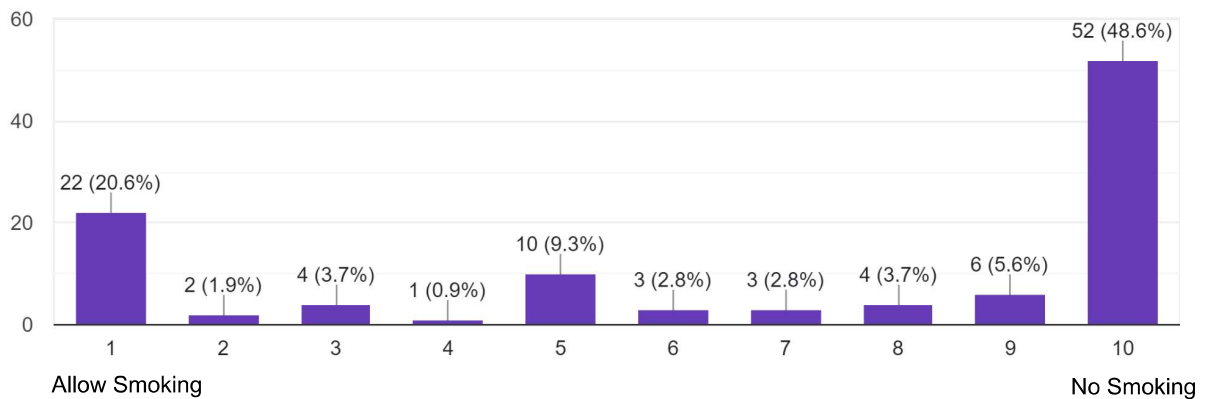

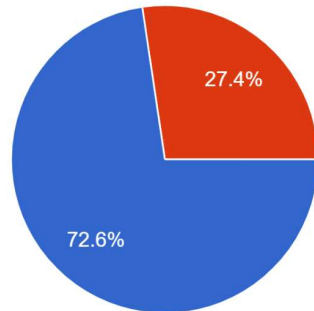


## Pet Rules - Potential Changes

The above pet rules are fine and do not need changing.

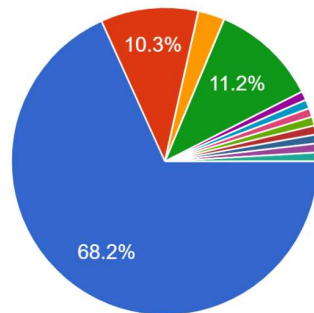

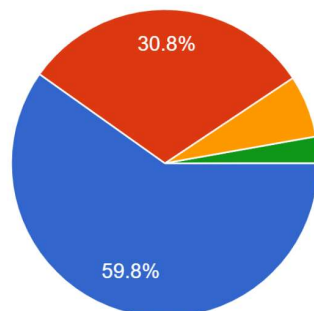


- 2 cat limit is ideal

How do you feel about the 1 dog limit?

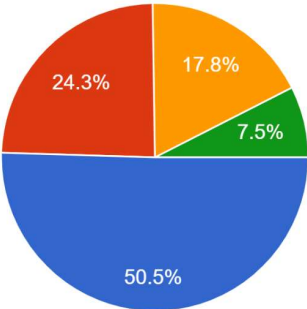
